Academic Assessment Results

With no academic foundation in our fraternity we are faced with a tough challenge; how can we address academic issues if we do not know what issues we are facing? In order to tackle this issue we created academic assessments to be filled out for each chapter in order for nationals to monitor the academic status of the fraternity on the national level.

The academic assessments have been a huge success as we now have data from all chapters to further develop our academic initiatives. These assessments have given us the ability to identify key issues chapters are facing academically and have enabled nationals to determine what changes are needed in order to meet our academic goals

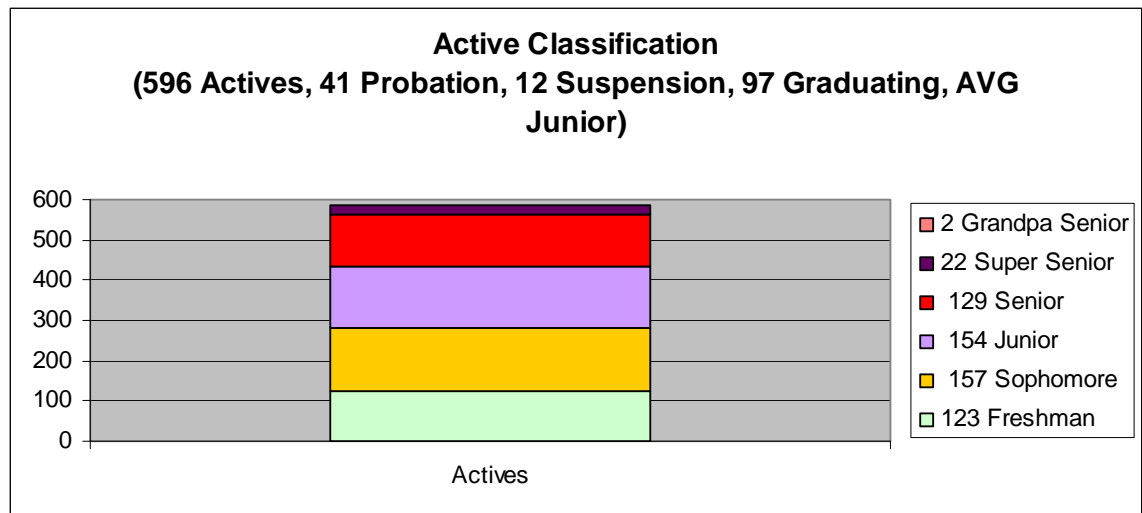


Figure 1: Active Classification

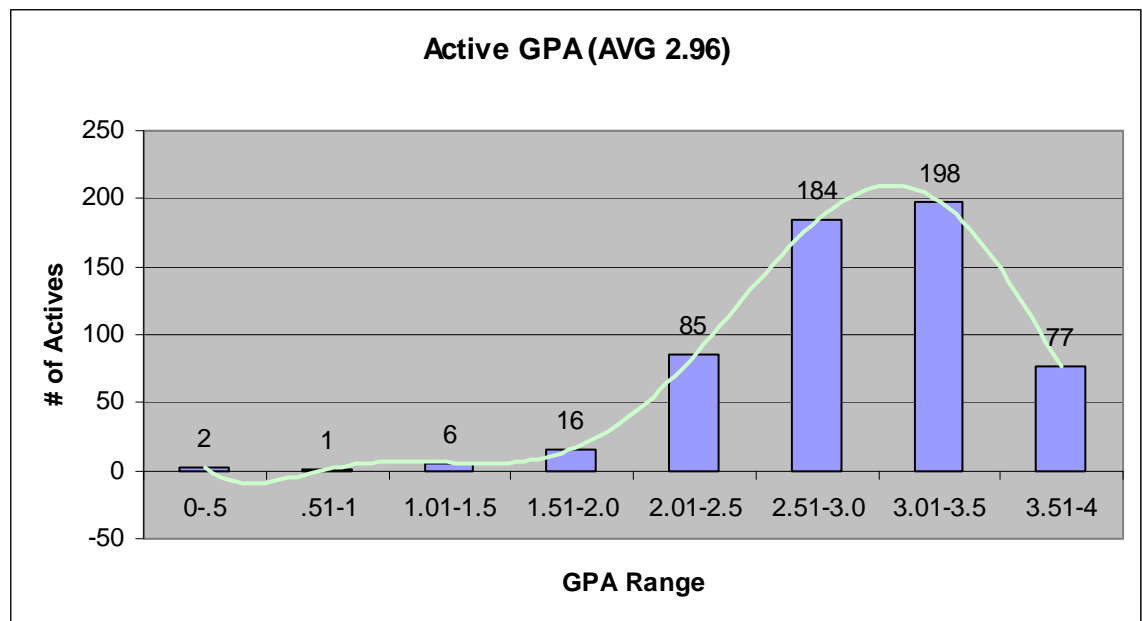


Figure 2: Active GPA

Our data shows that our active strength is at 596 with the average member being a junior. Our fraternity mostly consists of juniors and seniors as shown in figure 1. The average active's GPA is 2.96 and you will notice that our GPA distribution is skewed right as shown in figure 2. The average active house consists of 16 members with an average house GPA of 2.95. Other relevant information is not shown due to confidentiality.

We have carefully done a thorough analysis of all chapters throughout the nation with the aid of academic assessments.
