

# Jack Phoummarath Memorial Scholarship

### **Objective**

To honor the memory of one of our fallen brothers, Lambda Phi Epsilon will offer financial support to undergraduate members to attend the Undergraduate Interfraternity Institute (UIFI), a program run by the North-American Interfraternity Conference. The goal of this scholarship is twofold: 1) To assist in the endeavors of our undergraduate men in building the knowledge and skills necessary to improve themselves, their chapters, and the Greek community as a whole; 2) To provide our members with opportunities to connect with members of different organizations and broaden their understanding through external learning experience.

## **UIFI Description**

At UIFI, students will explore what it truly means to be a member of the Greek community and live a values-based life. Students will travel to Bloomington, IN to take part in a five day, immersive learning experience. There are 12 available sessions that attendees can take part in. Make sure you can attend one or more of the sessions listed below before applying:

#### Resources

The scholarship will cover the \$460 registration fee for attending UIFI. Additional expenses, including those incurred from travel, will be the responsibility of the attendee. Interested members should also check with their campus Greek professional to inquire about funding or travel assistance available from their office.



#### **Selection**

All members who are active in a chapter in good standing and have at least a 2.75 cumulative GPA are eligible to receive the scholarship. All applications must include a transcript, resume, and letter of recommendation and must be sent to southwest@lambdaphiepsilon.org by the deadline of Sunday April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2014 and no later. Currently two scholarships are available and applicants will be informed of their selection by April 20<sup>th</sup>. Once selected, the applicant must register with UIFI by April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014 or the scholarship will be voided.
