Active Chapter Requirements

The LFE International Board has the highest expectations for each of our chapters, and thus anticipates 100% Convention participation from every chapter. However, we understand that circumstances beyond chapters' control arise. Therefore, 25%* or more of each chapter is required to attend Convention to conduct business.

As written in the International Constitution: Section 3: House of Delegates Subsection A: Collegiate Delegates

Each Collegiate Chapter will be allotted a voting representative ("Delegate") for every 10 recognized members of their chapter, rounded down to the nearest multiple of 10. The number of members accounted for each Collegiate Chapter delegation will be averaged between the Spring and Fall registration periods of the previous calendar year. Collegiate Delegates must either currently be an Active Member or have been an Active Member during the previous Spring or Fall registration periods. Active Collegiate Chapters will each receive a minimum of two Delegates, while Associate Collegiate Chapters will each receive a minimum of one Delegate.

In-person and virtual registration are available. Each in-person registration will count as 1 attendee toward the 25% minimum chapter attendance requirement. Every two virtual registrations will count as 1 attendee toward the 25% minimum chapter attendance requirement.
